Evangelist Norma J. FaithWalker Bean is a lifelong AME. She was born and raised in Brooklyn, New York, and she is the widow of the Rev. Dr. Elmo A. Bean. She had/has four daughters (one deceased), eleven grandchildren, and one great grand-child. Evangelist Bean is a spiritual mother to many.

She has a degree in Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities from North Central College; a Master's Degree in Christian Counseling from Capital University, Columbus Ohio; and is a Reiki Practitioner and a Certified Life Coach (since 2013). She has worked for the Bureau of Child Welfare for the City of New York; for the Rehabilitation Service of North Central Ohio, and as a Mental Health Clinic/Counselor in Mansfield Ohio; and for the Department of Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities in Cleveland Ohio. She has owned two business: a Travel Agency and a Health and Wellness Business, both in Cleveland Ohio. Along the way she has studied as a classical musician, directed church choirs and youth choirs, and also sang in local theater productions.



In her Church Life, Evangelist Bean has been a member of the Women's Missionary Society for over 35 years, has been a life member since 2003, and has served as an officer at every level of the WMS. She is presently a member of the Amanda Smith WMS at Quinn Chapel, Louisville, KY, serving as the First Vice President, and is the Kentucky Conference WMS Worship Director.

Evangelist Bean was licensed an Evangelist in 1989 by Bishop Richard Allen Hildebrand in Cleveland Ohio. She began a ministry for women in 1998: "Women of Royal Destiny, Inc." (30 years in operation); and, "Children of Destiny" (for girls ages 11-17, focusing on pregnancy prevention/literacy/cultural awareness). She is a part of the Ministerial Staff at Quinn Chapel Louisville, where she is the Director of their Evangelistic Team, and Bishop Jeffrey Leath appointed Evangelist Bean as the Director of Evangelism for the Kentucky Conference.
